STM LOTTERY CONTINUES ITS SUPPORT TO KSK'S FOOD BANK PROGRAMME

STM Lottery Sdn. Bhd. (Formerly known as Sports Toto Malaysia Sdn. Bhd.) has renewed its monthly contribution to support the Kechara Soup Kitchen Society's (KSK) Food Bank programme for a year aiming to benefit a total of 448 needy families in Penang and Perak.

The collaboration with KSK started in 2021 when the country was facing a series of lockdowns due to the pandemic, STM Lottery had contributed a total of RM96,000 to the charitable organisation to send out food provision to over 700 families in the Klang Valley, Penang, Johor and Pahang.

"We are very honoured to be part of the noble cause as we know that many are facing the hardships of life during these challenging times and we are glad that there are kind people and organisations out there to help those in need.

"The reason that motivates us is our desire to join hands with other Malaysians to help Malaysian families in need during these difficult times," said STM Lottery Senior Communications Manager Mr. Giam Say Khoon.

STM Lottery has pledged to contribute a total of RM84,000 or RM7,000 a month to KSK starting from July 2022 to June 2023 to provide dry food provisions to a total of 448 needy families in Penang and Perak.

Other than cash contribution, STM Lottery has been sending its employees to take part in the KSK's Soup Kitchen programme since March 2022 to distributing food for the homeless and underprivileged group in Kuala Lumpur on a monthly basis.

"Through the Soup Kitchen programme, we want to promote the spirit of volunteerism among the staffs so that everyone has the opportunity to give something back to society," he said, adding that 65 STM Lottery employees had joined the programme as volunteers.

The collaboration with KSK is not just part of a corporate social responsibility under the company's Helping Hands programme but it is also in line with its sustainability effort to meet the Goal 2 of



the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals which is to “end hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture”.

The Helping Hands programme also supports social sustainability projects such as national sports development, festive donations, and environmental conservation projects.
